

Women's Art Festival Youth Artist Rules

The 26th Annual Women's Art Festival, held Saturday, December 8th, 2018, will have a dedicated space for young women artists, ages 10 – 18 to participate. Spaces are limited, so early application is encouraged. **For questions, see www.womensartfestival.com or contact Naomi Siegal at NLSiegal@aol.com or 612-250-5097.**

Youth and parents/guardians should read and understand the following rules for participation:

- 1) The Festival runs from 9:30 am-4:30 pm. Youth artists should plan to be there and selling the whole time. The venue opens for set-up at 7:00 am, please judge how much time your set-up will take and arrive accordingly. The event is held at the Colin Powell Youth Leadership Center, 2924 4th Ave S, Minneapolis. Free parking is available in the Wells Fargo Ramp a block away.
- 2) Youth artists aged 10-15 must have an adult on the premises with them throughout the day. This requirement may be waived for artists aged 16-18 with parental signature.
- 3) Two youth artists may pair up if they are making and selling the same goods, together. If they are friends selling separate goods, they may request to be placed side-by-side, but must register and pay separately.
- 4) Artists will pay registration fees of \$12 (ages 10-15) or \$20 (ages 16-18) per space, to be submitted with application.
- 5) Tables and chairs will be provided. Each artist/pair will be provided a 6 ft table on which to display works. However, it's helpful if a few youth bring their own tables. Please let Naomi know if you have and can bring a table. If you'd like to show your work other than on a table you can use the equivalent space as long as you bring any other display elements needed. Artists will be responsible, as well, for things such as table clothes, supplies, money/change, bags, etc. Nothing is to be attached to the walls or floor.
- 6) Any questions regarding appropriateness of art media, display, pricing, selling tips, etc may be addressed to Naomi by phone or email. This opportunity is intended to help young women learn what is involved in making and selling their products at art fairs. Please take advantage of the coaching available by Naomi or any of the other artists you encounter.
